Pacific Northwest Hydro, a local hose testing company, has reached out looking to hire additional workers for this summer. We have 3 members (Zack, Roberto, Josh) who have worked for them in the past and could give you details about the work. The company's email is attached.

E94 has been repaired and the crew loaded hose on Monday night.

I'm tracking some potential inclement weather this weekend and early next week. I'm seeing rain during the day and freezing overnight. Currently, there is no snow in the forecast. All engines, both tenders, both rescues, and the squads are carrying chains.

Speaking of bad weather, Station 91's generator is currently out of service. I have a tech coming on Thursday to take a look at it. If we lose power and the generator doesn't fire up, your key cards won't unlock the doors. I will unlock the man door by the dumpsters so that responders can get in. Also, the bay doors will need to be opened and closed manually.

A reminder that the district will pay you \$10 per night for every night that you sleep at the fire station. In order to qualify, you have to have a certification in something (doesn't matter what). Out-of-District volunteers should be putting in 36 volunteer hours per month. After they finish their 36 hours, they can also get paid to sleep at the station. See me for more info.
