This coming Saturday the 14<sup>th</sup> is Jefferson's appreciation event. We will send E92 with a crew to cover their district during the event, scheduled to be 4pm – 10pm. Dinner will be provided. We need an officer, AO, and 2 entry firefighters. If you are interested, contact Chief White or Chief Boyer.

Our appreciation event is March 28<sup>th</sup>, 6-9pm at the Tallman Brewery in Lebanon. Dinner and soda provided. You can purchase alcoholic beverages at the bar.

We are changing drill nights to Thursday nights starting July 1<sup>st</sup>. This is being done to better align with our neighbors Jefferson, Stayton, and Lebanon, who all drill on Thursday nights.

Wildland season is coming up fast. I detailed the training requirements in last week's Hot Topics. Field Days will be May 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>. If you haven't already received your NWCG FF Type 2, this is a good time to start the training. Just a reminder – if you want to deploy on a conflagration, you need to have your Type 2 AND you need to be certified NFPA FF1.

The missing NERIS and EHR reports are attached. As a general rule, I'll assign the "officer in charge" the responsibility of completing the EHR unless it's noted differently on the run report. We need to complete an EHR for every medical patient we see and we received a few nastygrams from OHA for not doing several last year.

A reminder that the district will pay you \$10 per night for every night that you sleep at the fire station. In order to qualify, you have to have a certification in something (doesn't matter what). Out-of-District volunteers should be putting in 36 volunteer hours per month. After they finish their 36 hours, they can also get paid to sleep at the station. See me for more info.
