Attached to the Hot Topics email is the list of missing or incomplete reports. With the switch over to NERIS, there are some boxes that aren't being checked. At this point, we don't have the ability to change the requirements on what needs to be filled out and what doesn't. I'd like to highlight a few boxes that currently aren't required (don't have the red asterisk) in ESO but the district wants you to fill out:

On the Core page:

- Actions Taken
- Station
- Report Writer

On the Resource page:

- Make sure to put the names of the responders on the rigs. This is how we assign points.

On the Medical page:

- Fill this out if it is an EMS alarm. Skip PCR, do "evaluation, status, and disposition."

If your report is on the "incomplete" list, check the above to make sure you filled all of the boxes out. I've taken a video of these highlights and put them up on the member's side of the website. The password to the member's side is ScioFire1888. Click on Training Videos and then click on NERIS Update 2/2/26.

Attached to the Hot Topics email are Memo's 26-1 Non-entry and Cadet Responses and 26-2 POV Responses. Please contact me with questions.

With the low attendance we had at last Monday's drill, we were only able to do rig checks on the two engines and the two rescues. If you have extra time on your hands, you could come down and knock out a rig check on the tenders, brush rigs, or squads.

A reminder that the district will pay you \$10 per night for every night that you sleep at the fire station. In order to qualify, you have to have a certification in something (doesn't matter what). Out-of-District volunteers should be putting in 36 volunteer hours per month. After they finish their 36 hours, they can also get paid to sleep at the station. See me for more info.
