Save the Date: Jaime Montgomery will be teaching a free "Adult Mental Health First Aid Certification Course for FIRE/EMS" March 29th here in Scio. The course is a fully immersive course to teach our Fire/EMS volunteers/personnel how to recognize early warning signs and symptoms of a mental health challenges all the way through steps during crisis. This is a course that teaches these scenarios with community members out in the field, amongst each other in the fire family as well as within themselves. Class size is limited to 20 students and will be opened up to surrounding districts if we don't fill it with Scio members. The class would run from 0900 – 1630 and lunch will be provided. There is about 45 minutes of pre-study required. A flyer and registration link is attached.
