Driving Policy Change (Temporary)

The district has several new members who have not yet been trained on driving emergency vehicles (rescues and larger) and there is a need to transport those members to emergency scenes. At times, there have been emergency calls to the district and no certified drivers have responded. We have had new members respond to the station in those situations and be unable to respond in a department vehicle, forcing them to take their personal vehicle to the scene.

Effective immediately, any member who is 18 years old or older, and who has not been trained and certified to drive a rescue or larger, may drive either F-150 or Yukon under the following conditions:

- They demonstrate proficiency to the fire chief or either division chief in driving one of the above vehicles and:
- They respond to the emergency scene Code 1

Once they demonstrate proficiency, they may also drive these vehicles while running errands.

When responding in this capacity in C-905, your radio designator will be Squad 91

When responding in this capacity in C-901, your radio designator will be Squad 92

When responding in this capacity in the Yukon, your radio designator will Squad 93

This Driving Policy Change (temporary) will be reviewed in the month of December for possible inclusion into the Policy and Operating Guidelines manual.
